FY11 Budget Development Judicial Offices



- **Article V** Section 14 (c) of the Florida Constitution states: "*Counties shall be required to fund the cost of communications services, existing radio systems, existing multi-agency criminal justice information systems, and the cost of construction or lease, maintenance, utilities, and security of facilities for the trial courts, public defenders' offices, state attorneys' offices, and the offices of the clerks of the circuit and county courts performing court-related functions. Counties shall also pay reasonable and necessary salaries, costs, and expenses of the state courts system to meet local requirements as determined by general law*" [emphasis added]



 - \$29,836 for 1 Courier (represents 66% of total coming from Board and the remainder from other counties – total salary \$45,205) *
 - \$38,099 for Alternative Sanctions Coordinator (represents 66% of total coming from Board and the remainder from other counties – total salary \$57,725) **
 - \$219,596 for technology (\$210,988 for 66% of 5 IT FTEs)

Judicial Circuit-wide Transaction Fund

- **Before**
 - The Board fully funded the budgets of the expenses for the surrounding counties in the 8th Circuit within the General Fund.
 - The surrounding counties, representing approximately 1/3 of the Circuit's population, would reimburse the General Fund 100%.
- **Now**
 - Used for the expenditures and reimbursement revenues, separate from the General Fund.



General Fund – Local Requirements

Fla. Stat. 29.008 (2) (c) 2&3 states that the "Chief Judge shall submit to the board of county commissioners a tentative budget request for local requirements for the ensuing fiscal year" and that "the board of county commissioners shall thereafter treat the certification in accordance with the county's budgetary procedures" and "determine whether to provide funding, and to what extent it will provide funding, for salaries, costs, and expenses ."

Therefore, local requirements are discretionary reliant on Board approval.

 ** Only 66% of the positions under the "Mandated" and "Reasonable and Necessary" columns are funded with the General Fund, the remainder is funded by reimbursed revenue from other counties in the 6th Circuit in a separate special revenue fund. The Administrative Assistant is funded 50% in the General Fund.

 - State has amended the Statute to allow this fee to be increased up to \$30 with Board action/approval
- Revenues can be used for "state court facilities" including leases, maintenance, utilities, and capital
- FY11 budgeted revenue is \$850,000




FY11 Budget Development Judicial Offices

- Participants have reduced, FTEs have been moved, General Fund has absorbed some.


